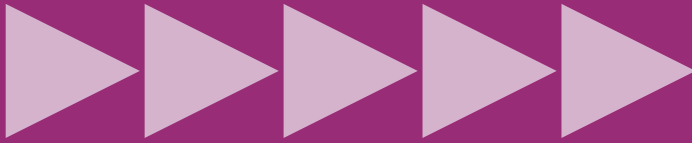
Finding a job that is right for you can be difficult. Especially if you have not worked for a while, or if you are worried about the effect it may have on your benefits.
